Illinois WIC Disaster Plan of Action

The action plan provides for a statement of disaster; which agencies are affected, covered time frame, persons affected, and a checklist of actions being put in place (IL WIC PPM AD 14).

Policies and procedures, <u>marked</u> below, are in effect to carry out this disaster plan IL WIC PPM AD 14):	
Expedited Processing of Disaster-Related Evacuees	
Disaster-related evacuees are special nutritional risk applicants and receive an expedited ertification processing. They must be notified of their eligibility or ineligibility within 10 days of the date of the first request for benefits.	
Every effort must be made to certify these individuals immediately, and at a naximum, within 10 days of their request (whether by phone or visit to the WIC agency).	
Verification of Certification Information (VOC)	
A person with VOC information must not be denied participation in Illinois because he individual does not meet Illinois' specific eligibility criteria.	
When possible, VOC information should be provided by the local agency to WIC participants when a disaster-related evacuation is anticipated.	
Each evacuee must receive VOC information from the local agency upon certification. This helps ensure continuation of benefits when returning to their home state.	
Physical Presence	
Physical presence is exempt; the disaster presents a serious health concern or barrier to physically accessing the clinic.	
Certification can be completed via mailing of paperwork, telephone interview or lectronic mail (email) by completing the appropriate screens in the WIC MIS.	

Documentation of income, residency and identification
Recertifications: Documentation is suspended; carry forward the previous certification information for the recertification in the WIC MIS.
Certifications: review the Illinois WIC Rights and Responsibilities Form in the WIC MIS and indicate reason no signature obtained, if applicable; verify proofs of eligibility by encrypted email of digital/photo proof, secure video call or via verbal documentation and verify at curbside. 1. If able to verify only two of the three required proofs, staff may complete a shortened 30-Day Certification following policy IL WIC PPM CS 3.7.
2. If unable to provide any verification of income, residency and/or identity the participant may still be eligible. WIC regulations state agencies may authorize the certification of applicants when no proof exists (7 CFR 246.7(c)(2)(i)). In this rare instance staff should document the situation in the WIC MIS General Notes section. One month of benefits should be issued, and participant scheduled to return within 30 days.
In cases where disaster-related evacuees or refugees move in with another household, the displaced individuals are considered homeless and treated as a separate economic unit.
Nutrition Risk Assessment
Recertifications: Reassess certification to the extent possible; blood test, height or length, and weight measurements can be deferred for 90 days.
Applicants who are disaster-related evacuees or refugees: nutritional risk is met using the homeless code.
Applicants-all other: Assess certification to the extent possible; blood test, height or length, and weight measurements can be deferred for 90 days.
Certification Periods
Certification Periods for Breastfeeding Women, Infants, and Children: within the parameters of section 7 CFR 246.7(g)(3) of the WIC regulations, the certification period is extended by a period not to exceed 30 days.
Food Package Assignment
Ready-to-Use formula may be issued in circumstances where the water supply may be contaminated or is unavailable for mixing.
Medical Documentation for Medically Prescribed Formulas
Participants presenting another State's benefits that specify a medically prescribed formula, may be issued benefits for the specified item, up to the end of their certification period.
Participants without benefits, who can provide the name of the medically prescribed formula that the individual was receiving before relocating, may be issued one (1) month of food benefits for that specific item.
