Breastfeeding: It Matters (February 2017)

1. The central organ of the infant's immune system is the thymus.
2. The thymus produces oligosaccharides.
3. Human milk oligosaccharides (HMOs) serve as food for microbes in the digestive tract.

5. Breastmilk has around 1,000 constituents.
6. Discussing the risks of using formula is more effective at changing behavior than discussing the benefits of breastfeeding.
7. Studies show that when the baby's father supports breastfeeding, more than 90% of mothers are more likely to choose to breastfeed.
