The following are the Department approved resources for assessment of adjunctive eligibility as explained in IL WIC PM CS 4.3.

Medicaid Title XIX, SNAP, or TANF Notice of Decision Letter	"Notice of Decision" letter is mailed to applicant informing them of their eligibility for benefits one time per year. The notice:  • would indicate they are approved for benefits  • would indicate eligible time period – a start and end date  ** Notice of Decision letters will not indicate Title 19 vs. Title 21 cases however agencies may enroll participants with this letter.

Medi System	Local agency staff may access the Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) "Medi" system to determine if an applicant has an active Medicaid case paid with Title XIX (19).  To be determined income eligible via Medicaid Adjunctive Eligibility the case must:  • Be active at the time of the WIC appointment: review "begin date" and "end date".  • "Title XIX" listed in the Special Information section.  • If the case is "Title XXI" or "State Funded", those are not WIC eligible
